Dear Northwest Christian School Family,

Like most schools, Northwest Christian runs regular emergency drills, practicing our procedures for fire, earthquake, and lockdown scenarios. Well, any of these emergencies are terrible, I particularly hate running lockdown drills as this prepares us to be ready for the worst of the worst. It is not only direct threats to a school that may lead to a lockdown scenario, but also police activity in the area, especially when chasing suspects.

I am communicating this because on Wednesday we practice our fall lockdown drill. This drill sometimes scares some younger students and I am inviting you to have an age-appropriate discussion with your child in advance of the drill. Our classroom teachers will also be addressing this in advance as well with the goal of being ready to know how to react should our school ever need to go on lockdown for some reason.

On a much lighter and more encouraging note, last night's biblical archaeology seminar was absolutely fascinating! Tony Moore presented a brief history of Egypt, connecting many of the stories and artifacts that he brought to the biblical narrative. His artifacts are amazing! He has brought dozens and dozens of genuine antiquities dating from 1500 to 4000 years old; he even lets the audience handle these rare and precious antiquities. He will be presenting each night this week at 7 o'clock. Hope you are able to join us!
